With the Request ID card option, you can request an ID card to be mailed to you after verifying your mailing address.

The UHCSR Mobile App is available on both GooglePlay and the App Store. After you've downloaded it to your mobile device, click on the ID card icon in the bottom left corner of the home screen. Once the ID card image displays, you'll have the option to download, fax or email your ID card image.
